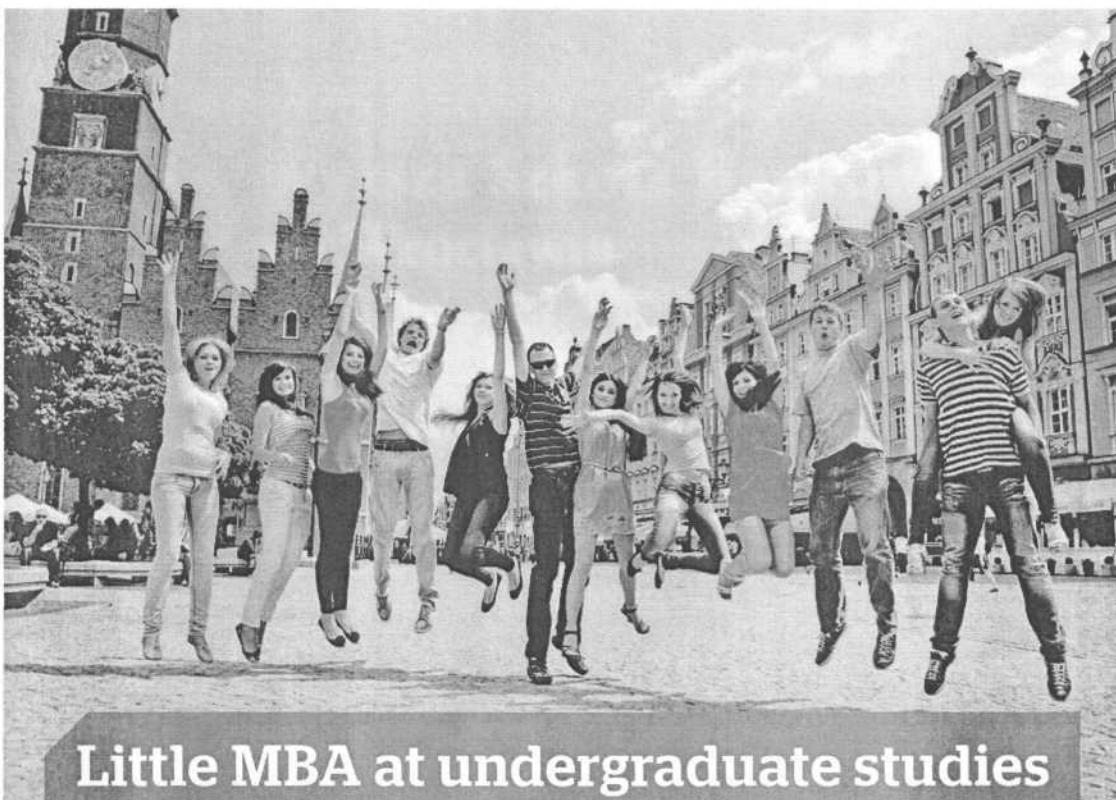

Study in Wrocław School of Banking

What is Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA)?

- Speciality at 3-year-long full-time undergraduate studies (Bachelor's degree) at the Management degree course,

- **International atmosphere:** classes are conducted by Polish and international lecturers with participation of Polish students as well as students from Europe and various parts of the world.

Required documents

- 2 colour photos (compliant with requirements for ID photos: size 45' 35 mm, left hand side of the face with a visible ear)
- a passport or an identity card (if the applicant has one)
- a visa, a residence card or any other document which gives the right to stay in the Republic of Poland. Foreigners who are not entitled to stay in the Republic of Poland must submit a separate statement that will immediately apply for a visa as soon as they receive a confirmation of admission to studies at WSB
- an insurance policy (if the applicant has one) or an insurance card (if the applicant has one); in the event of the lack of documents- a statement of joining the National Health Fund (a copy of the agreement including a copy of payment of the first insurance premium within 7 days of commencing the education)
- a doctor's certificate confirming a good health condition and the lack of contraindications for commencing studies at the selected course and the form of education
- a document certifying the command of English - if required and if the applicant has one
- A certificate obtained abroad may be recognized for the purposes of pursuing undergraduate studies in Poland on the basis of international agreements or in case of the lack of agreements by way of recognition. Certificates recognition is granted by the School Superintendent appropriate for the place of residence of a person applying for recognition and in the event of no such place: Kurator Oświaty we Wrocławiu, Plac Powstańców Warszawy 1, 50-951 Wrocław, Poland, phone +48 71 340 63 48. The confirmation of applying for the nostrification procedure shall be submitted to the Admissions Office, however the student is obliged to submit the nostrification of the certificate to the Dean's Office of undergraduate studies not later than by the end of the first semester.
- the confirmation of paying an admission fee that can be paid by bank transfer into the account number **22 1020 5242 0000 2402 0118 1429** or when enrolling in the Admissions Office (not applicable to the promotion period of 0 PLN of the admission fee)
